Now this is where I come to the difficult part which has caused me a good deal of concern as to how I can present the fuller concept of THE VAST EXTENT OF THE MARTH AND OUR POSITION WITHEN IT. Your letter arriving the morning following such film certainly helped to ambed the film even more strongly in mind.

Together with many items taken from various authorities of a past generation.
