Dear Brothers and Sisters,

To commence a letter with words of regret is bad but I can do nothing else. The long delay has been caused by several things. Foremost has been my troublesome heart condition which has caused me to lay-off lectures for many months past. Over that, the collapse in health collapsed also my business. This resulted in failure to collect just payments and a very worrying time with the Tax-man and ever present demands. All this did not give any rest to deal with the staggering inflow of letters from all over the world. One of the main objects of our removal to the new address was to seek pleasant resting or dwelling place (As the chosen house name above indicates) (only ONE mention in the Bible. Can you find it?) but alas the pressure has followed me here. I'm going to try and take part in a college debate "The world-Round or Flat" to be held at Bedford college London March 12. The wife helps with "Go on kill yourself!" She's seen the faints, falls and the dose of "shingles" I had just recently.

With the above bits and pieces I have not been able to do a tape for you although in our old address I had constructed a soundproof recording room. I never got around to using it. I had to wait until late in the year (67) before I found anyone with a tape recorder which would take the 7" spool you sent. Finally I had a sales manager to get a new model out of his window, set it up and test your spool to find out if you had any message on it for me. Evidently there was nothing recorded from you. I have a Philips cassette recorder plays sealed cassettes off 60 or 90 minutes. (Had just started to tape lectures before general health trouble) These I think are an advance on the previous machines. Also smaller for other things that I have cut or interfered with. Other than that I have

a Grundig TK 14 taking 5" spools. But I've never done much with it. I will try and tape the debate at the Bedford college. If it is successful I may be able to transfer on to another tape to include to you at some (not too) later date. Its pretty certain that all of you, being so used to the use of tape recorders will know more about them than I do.

I hope you approve of the new letterheading. It will not cost the Society anything because I hope to get the cost settled by contra a/c which is one of those which have not been settled before I had to finish business.

The mention of money brings to mind that I have to thank Lavington friends for your kind contribution to the literature fund which is kept entirely distinct from my account at the Bank. Other than your help there was only ~~one~~ other of ~~ten~~ shillings through the whole year. A few Americans are now beginning to enclose postal coupons with their letters but most seem to think that we are a big concern and the American mind thinks only in big business; they, and most students of today, have everything far too easy and to realise that there are still Bible-punching foolish people in the world who still believe the world to be "flat" is bad enough for them, but to drive the matter a stage further and say we are not a profit making society, must absolutely floor them. We, or I, think that the great objective at this present time, is to be available to contact those who honour, or desire to honour, the actual statements of God and His Christ regarding what The Lord God has made...His creation...whereby He claims to be THE CREATOR.

I do not favour the 10% tithing as practised by the Armstrongs, Mormons, Romans and all other bodies. I've seen far too much of the accumulation of property. The handling of millions of dollars or stocks etc., all in the name of doing God's work. Forgetting that The Christ whilst on earth illustrated that He could easily accomplish all that was required. At the same time stating the fact that His Father was even greater than himself. It is NOT in numbers or cash that God's will is accomplished. Rather those whose heart is tender towards Him are called and if they lack some measure of understanding they are directed into the path which leads to abundant life on earth beneath an enlarged heaven. The new city of Jerusalem and The Christ's government dominating with the re-established law of the Lord. "For those whom He has known beforehand He has also predestined to bear the likeness of His Son, that He might be the Eldest in a VAST family of brothers; and those whom He has predestined He has also CALLED..."

You requested a map of the "Flat Earth" world. No such map is of course made by cartographers or publishers who deal with the support of modern education intended to continue the anti-God globeite lie. Now this is where I come to the difficult part which has caused me a good deal of concern as to how I can present the fuller concept of THE VAST EXTENT OF THE EARTH AND OUR POSITION WITHIN IT. As you can easily understand I get letters from the school pupil who can scarce govern a lead pencil let alone spell, and from gentlemen, as yourself, who evince deep understanding and enquiry. The range of enquiry also is staggering.

I am stuck at this moment to formulate a sequence or statement which will -at the same time- be satisfactory and intelligible to both classes of enquirer. I feel that the only way will call for two papers. One couched in story form to be acceptable to the youngest reader (if their conditioned teachers would ever allow) and the other with a straight forward appeal to such workers and thinkers as yourself.

The whole of our Zetetic struggle to understand the workings of the phenomena abounding around us does not call for high-sounding labels to matters or the need for fantastic formula. So direct is our approach without man's use of theories and assumptions, that we run the risk of being discarded as being too naive.

You mention the Greek whose estimate of the circumference of the earth was 250,000 stadia. Could we not relate "circumference" to perimeter or boundary ?. Not related to a globe, but rather to the plane area which under the diurnal motion of the sun over an unmoving surface of earth creates and maintains the inner and outer ring or boundary -the ice barrier.? The pamphlet (which I may decide to send together with this letter) will speedily show the antarctic circle which had twice, at least, been logged at some 60,000 miles or more.

If you can carry the picture of earth matter extending in EVERY direction from our point of habitation, i.e. laterally and in depth and then dispelling former ideas of infinite, upward and outer "space" you can then arrive at the question point of earth extension upward -HIGHER- than the small circulating bodies of sun etc; higher than this heaven which we foul-up! We are in the lowest heaven! You dear Sir mention The Christ. He had to pass through all heavens to the highest heaven. Scudge it off if you wish, but I have, lacking that warm beer, tried to, without offence, answer your question. Your comment in due course is certainly expected. If the religious or scriptural note in my final remarks do not offend you, I could perhaps at a later date send you a photo of the concept of plural heavens...the "heaved-up structures"

subject. The interested student must have visual aids to which he can refer. Therefore I propose, as soon as sufficient funds allow, to reprint some of the works of former "ZETETICS" (Gk. verb 'zeteo' to search-out, trace-out, search for facts as opposed to theorising; etc:) "Flat Earthists" so-called. Added to such works which dealt with basic facts of water levels, railways, distant views etc: impossible upon a whirling "globe". Together with many items taken from various authorities of a past generation. All very good stuff, but such gentlemen had no idea what-so-ever of this so-called "space-age" and the seeming confounding evidences of the popular news photographs which result from astronauts and voyaging capsules.

In this latter field I have been forced by these major events to search for the answer which maintains those FACTS searched out by the former workers and find reasonable, demonstratable answers which support our well founded original statements.

To go further than this, the student must be firstly well conversant with the distribution of earth mass as in the Polar Projection Map.
